## **WEEKEND IN REGGIO EMILIA**

2 days/1 night

FIRST DAY: Arrival and visit to a wonderful farm on the first hills of the city. Here you will discover the secrets of two special products: the Traditional Balsamic Vinegar of Reggio Emilia, which is aged for at least twelve years in the attics of the acetaie, and the famous Lambrusco, typical wine well-known all over the world. The visit will end with a tasting of both products. Lunch in a traditional bistrot. In the afternoon visit of Reggio Emilia city centre, starting from Prampolini Square where the Cathedral rises nearby the Baptistery and the Town Hall, with the Hall of the Tricolour Flag, where in 1797 the Italian flag was first adopted. Then the Basilica of San Prospero, the Sanctuary of the Beata Vergine della Ghiara with The Crucifixion by Guercino, the unmissable Municipal Theatre and the possibility to visit the current exhibition at Palazzo Magnani. Dinner in a typical restaurant. Overnight stay at the hotel.

**SECOND DAY:** Breakfast at the hotel and visit to a cheese factory to discover the secrets of **Parmigiano-Reggiano**, the King of Cheeses. Lunch in a traditional restaurant. In the afternoon the **Calatrava Park Project**, which consists of the bridges and the High Speed Train Station Mediopadana by the architect Santiago Calatrava. Moreover, the **Maramotti Contemporary Art Collection** completes this urban dialogue between art and architecture. Departure.

## THE WONDERS IN THE VALLEY OF THE PO RIVER

3 days/2 nights

FIRST DAY: Arrival in Reggiolo and accomodation in the hotel. Guided visit in Brescello, the small town famous for being the set for Peppone and Don Camillo film series. We will visit the square, the church of the town which preserves the famous speaking Cricifix. Then, we will pass in front of Peppone's house, the people's bell and, in the end, we will go inside the two museums dedicated to the movies: "Peppone and Don Camillo Museum" and "Guareschi Museum and the Cinema". Lunch in a traditional restaurant nearby. In the afternoon transfer to Correggio for a visit to a very famous wine producer to know his unbelivable Lambrusco. Then we will visit his wonderful acetaia, ending with a tasting session of both products. Dinner at leisure and overnight stay at the hotel.

SECOND DAY: Breakfast in the hotel and transfer to the countryside near Parma. Visit at the birth house of the great musician Giuseppe Verdi at Le Roncole. Transfer to Busseto to visit the Verdi Theatre and the Barezzi Museum. In the late morning we will discover the secrets of the prestigious Culatello di Zibello, ending the visit with an amazing tasting session. Typical lunch in "osteria". In the afternoon vist at the Ducal palace of Colorno, still beautifully preserved and unique in its kind, also called the "Little Versailles", the summer residence of the dukes of Parma and Piacenza. Traditional dinner in a restaurant close to the Po River and overnight stay at the hotel.

THIRD DAY: Breakfast at the hotel and guided visit of Sabbioneta (UNESCO Heritage), the "ideal town" founded by Duke Vespasiano Gonzaga, an extraordinarily well-kept example of Renaissance architecture and town planning. After a brief walk along the city walls, the tour will continue with a visit to the Ducal Palace, the Garden Palace with the Gallery of the Ancient and the Teatro all'Antica (theatre in the style of the ancient). Lunch at leisure. Free visit of the Unesco Heritage Mantua, the enchanting city of the Gonzaga family. Departure.

Continuing the adventure of the "Cavallino Rampante", you will visit the Ferrari Museum in Maranello: here you will see legendary cars from the past and prototypes for the future. Typical dinner with Reggio Emilia specialties, in a Michelin starred restaurant, symbol of the local tradition. Overnight stay at the hotel.

**FOURTH DAY:** Breakfast at the hotel. Free day in **Bologna** using High Speed Train Station, starting from the new Calatrava Railway Station in Reggio Emilia. We advice to discover the "gourmet" side of Bologna, focusing on the medieval market area. Then to enjoy the authentic atmosphere of Bologna, home to the oldest University of Europe, featuring one of the best preserved medieval centers of Italy. Once back in Reggio Emilia, dinner in a local restaurant. Overnight stay at the hotel.

FIFTH DAY: Breakfast at the hotel and visit to a producer of Parmigiano-Reggiano cheese, ending with a tasting session. Lunch in a restaurant of one of the most well-known chef of Reggio Emilia. Departure.

## INDUSTRIAL ARCHEOLOGY IN REGGIO EMILIA

2 days/1 night

FIRST DAY: Arrival in the morning in Reggio Emilia and accommodation in the hotel. Meeting with a local guide at the Loris Malaguzzi International Center - former Locatelli Complex. Visit to what was the Emilian headquarters of Locatelli company. You will discover the history of this building: a complex for the maturing of Grana cheese, built in the 1920s in the Santa Croce district of Reggio Emilia, and now, after the acquisition by the Municipality in 1998 in the context of a urban regeneration program, which has become an important cultural center, dedicated to the Loris Malaguzzi pedagogue, famous all over the world. Later visit to Tecnopolo - Ex Officine Reggiane: mechanical research center, mechatronics, construction, agri-food, energy and environment, start-up incubator and spin-off. At the end of the visit, lunch at the restaurant of the International Center. In the afternoon visit to the Ex Officine Reggiane Archives, at the Istoreco headquarters, in the Chiostri di San Domenico, located in the historical centre of Reggio Emilia: a wealth of documents, images and objects linked to the history of the Former Officine. In the evening, typical dinner in a traditional restaurant in the city centre. Overnight stay at the hotel.

**SECOND DAY:** Breakfast at hotel. In the morning visit to the **Maramotti Collection**, former production site of the famous fashion house Max Mara and now private gallery of contemporary art with international works from 1945 to today. Free lunch at leisure. In the afternoon guided tour of the **BAI Max Mara**, library and archive of business, which aims to order, preserve, research and enhance the history of Max Mara Fashion Group. The specialist library in the fashion sector is aimed at researching new trends, while the business archive gathers the historical testimonies of the company as well as fifty thousand items, including garments and clothing accessories, sketches, textiles, documents, advertising material, furniture and multimedia objects from 1951 to today. At the end of the visit, departure.

. Parma Italian Capital of Culture 2020

A full program of over 400 events, exhibitions, concerts and initiatives that will take place throughout the year 2020 in the city of Parma and which will also involve the nearby cities of Reggio Emilia and Piacenza.

. Fotografia Europea 2019 - Reggio Emilia

International cultural festival dedicated to contemporary photography. Born in 2006, it is promoted by Palazzo Magnani Foundation and the Municipality of Reggio Emilia. This edition the theme will be ""FANTASIES. Stories, rules, inventions". The Opening days will take place from the 17th to the 19th of April and the exhibitions will last until the 24th of May.

. Festival Aperto - Reggio Emilia

On the stages of the three main theaters of Reggio Emilia, dance, theater, music and performing arts trace each year in autumn new fascinating routes between tradition and modernity.

. Corteo Storico Matildico – Quattro Castella (Reggio Emilia)

A reenactment of historical character, which takes place annually, the last weekend of May in Quattro Castella, in the province of Reggio Emilia, since 1955. The episode of the "re-enfeoffment" of Matilda of Canossa by the emperor Henry V in May 1111.

festival filosofia - Modena, Carpi and Sassuolo

"Machines" the theme chosen for the 20th edition, from the 18th to 20th of September. The Festival changes for three days the face of the cities of Modena, Carpi and Sassuolo with masterly lessons by protagonists of the Italian and international cultural scene.

. Festival Verdi - Parma and Busseto

Important Italian music festival of opera. It is held every year in October (Verdi's birth month) in Parma, Busseto and in the Verdi area.

SECOND DAY: Breakfast at the hotel. Visit to a producer Parmigiano-Reggiano cheese discovering how it is produced, in the same way since eight centuries. From the milk production to the aging, an expert will explain all the phases of this fantastic product famous all over the world to be the King of Cheeses. At the end, tasting session of different ages. Then visit to a farm which produces Traditional Balsamic Vinegar of Reggio Emilia. The Balsamico, which is obtained from the cooked grape, must mature with a slow acetification derived from natural fermentation and progressive concentration in barrels of different woods. Finally, tasting of different kind of Balsamic Vinegar. Lunch in a traditional restaurant on the hills. Departure.

In the evening, gourmet dinner in a 1 Michelin starred restaurant, considered by gourmets to be a temple to Emilian cuisine. Overnight stay at the hotel.

SECOND DAY: Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to the Southern Parma area. Visit to a prestigious farm where black pigs belonging to an ancient local breed are reared outdoors in a protected natural landscape which is surrounded by valleys, geysers known locally as "barboj" and oak forests. Then visit at the factory in Traversetolo where their ham is cured, ending with a special carving board for a delicious lunch. In the afternoon visit to a producer of Malvasia located in front of Torrechiara Castle. At the end of the visit tasting session of three different wines and possibility to visit the castle. Dinner in a traditional restaurant and overnight stay at the hotel.

THIRD DAY: Breakfast at the hotel and morning at leisure to visit Reggio Emilia city centre: the Cathedral, Prampolini Square, Basilica of San Prospero, the Sanctuary of the Beata Vergine della Ghiara, Fontanesi Square and expecially visit the current exhibition at Palazzo Magnani. Transfer to Scandiano to have lunch in a very famous restaurant of that area. Visit to Boiardo Fortress, built in the XII century which now, after the many changes over the years, it conserves different styles: Medieval, Renaissance, Baroque and Modern. After the visit, departure.

Then visit to his wonderful Acetaia, where the **Traditional Balsamic Vinegar of Reggio Emilia** is made since long time. Ending with a tasting session of both products to discover their aromas and tasty flavours. Dinner in Reggio Emilia city centre and overnight stay at the hotel.

**SECOND DAY:** Breakfast at the hotel. Discovering how the famous **Parmigiano-Reggiano cheese** is produced in a local farm. Lunch at the end of the visit, tasting local culinary specialties. Afternoon at leisure in **Reggio Emilia city centre:** the Cathedral, the Basilica of San Prospero, the astonishing Valli Municipal Theatre and time to make some shopping and to discover boutiques of local artisans. **Special dinner in the restaurant of the most well-known chef of the city.** Overnight stay at the hotel.

THIRD DAY: Breakfast at hotel. In the morning, guided visit to the studio of a famous jewelry maker, located in the historical center of the city.

You will follow the phases that lead to the creation of unique jewels, that now you can find in the windows of the most famous museums of the world such as the Louvre, the Vatican Museums, Versailles and the Nathional Geographic in Washington. A combination of preciousness and fantasy, of classic and modern, it is what you can notice observing precious stones that marry poor materials up to tar, baroque Japanese pearls of colored water that blend with hand-cut stones, worked in India along the streets of Rajasthan, with enamels and rutilated guartzes. This talented jewelry designer also boasts important collaborations with international Maison. At the end of the visit, lunch in a bistro in the historical centre. In the afternoon, visit to another important craftsman from Reggio Emilia, who offers innovative furniture and architecture solutions revisiting the ancient "cocciopesto" technique. A real artistic studio that proposes in a personal way, both for the polychrome mixture and for the inlay work, this technique already used in Roman times. The "coccio" (earthenware) ground more or less fine and mixed with binders and inerts, allows you to create objects of various types and sizes. In the evening, free dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

**FOURTH DAY:** Breakfast at the hotel. Visit at a **rural farm** on the first hills of Reggio Emilia, where the owners will prepare a special tasting of their **jams** and preserves using their fruits and vegetables in season. Lunch in a local tavern with typical food of Reggio Emilia. Departure.

## **FAMILY EXPERIENCE**

The Loris Malaguzzi International Centre, opened in February 2006, is a dedicated meeting place where professional development and research intersect for people in Reggio Emilia, Italy and the world who wish to innovate education and culture. The Centre is an international place open to all ages, to ideas, to different cultures, to hope and to imagination. A place of the possible, both necessary and useful for the concept of a city ascribing value to change. A large space in which research, innovation, and experimentation are carried out on educational content and processes in the different fields of knowledge. The Centre is located on the site of the former Locatelli warehouses, purchased in 1998 by the Municipality of Reggio Emilia and destined to become the catalyst and symbol of the transformation of the city's northside. A place that keeps the central focus on children and their potentials, that aims to offer opportunities for creativity to children, youth, and families, and new opportunities to the international educational community and to all those who embrace and pursue learning and innovation. The development of the Malaguzzi Centre is promoted jointly by Reggio Children and the Istituzione of the Municipal Infant-toddler Centers and Preschools of Reggio Emilia. The Loris Malaguzzi International Centre houses the new Urban Ateliers, the Ray of Light Atelier, the Marco Gerra exhibition hall, the Reggio Children Bookshop, the Documentation and Educational Research Centre of the Municipal Infant-toddler Centres and Preschools of Reggio Emilia, the Annamaria and Marco Gerra Auditorium, the Research and Innovation Space, and since October 2011, in progressive development, the spaces dedicated to food at Pause - Atelier of Tastes (cafeteria, restaurant, grocery shop). Considering this remarkable experience in children's education, Reggio Emilia offers excellent itineraries for families, with a particular attention to values and experience dedicated to early childhood.









## **ENOGASTRONOMY FROM EMILIA ROMAGNA**

7 days/ 6 nights

**FIRST DAY:** Arrival in Reggio Emilia and accommodation in the hotel. **Cooking lesson** to learn the preparation of the traditional gnocco fritto (fried dumplings), which will be tasted with salami, cold cuts, Parmigiano Reggiano. In the afternoon guided visit of **Reggio Emilia city centre** to discover the Cathedral, the Basilica of San Prospero, Fontanesi Square, the current exhibition at **Palazzo Magnani** and to do some shopping. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

**SECOND DAY:** Breakfast at the hotel. Visit at **Museo Ferrari Maranello**. Transfer to Modena for a walk in the historical centre. Buffet lunch with typical products. Visit to a producer of **Balsamic Vinegar** and tasting. Once returned in Reggio Emilia, dinner in a traditional restaurant. Overnight stay at the hotel.

**THIRD DAY:** Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, transfer to the northern area of Parma to visit a producer of **Culatello di Zibello** with tasting to discover its secrets. Lunch in a traditional "osteria". Afternoon at leisure in the refined city of **Parma**. Dinner at leisure and overnight stay at the hotel.

**FOURTH DAY:** Arrival in Romagna, traditional lunch in the city centre of Rimini. In the afternoon **guided visit of the Roman Rimini**, the ancient

Ariminum where Julius Caesar pronounced his famous speech "The die is taken". Visit the Arch of Augustus, the Forum, the Tiberius Bridge, and then move on to the medieval part of town with the imposing Castel Sismondo and the Cathedral, one of the first masterpieces of the Renaissance. Transfer to the hotel, welcome dinner and overnight stay.

FIFTH DAY: Guided visit of Santarcangelo di Romagna, wonderful medieval town and birthplace of Pope Clement XV which is dedicated to the Ganganelli Arch. Visit to a traditional printshop, which still uses a seventeenth-century wooden mangle to stretch the canvas, and then printed by hand to rust. Transfer to a farm and cooking lesson to learn all the secrets of the culinary traditions of Romagna, preparing piadina, cassoni (stuffed flatbread) and tagliatelle. Lunch tasting what has been prepared, accompanied by wines of the estate. After lunch visit at the winery and vineyards of the estate. Transfer to San Marino, the most ancient Republic of the world. Time at leisure to discover the town and to do some shopping. Dinner at leisure and overnight stay at the hotel.

SIXTH DAY: Guided visit of Mondaino, on the border between Romagna and Marche region. Walk in the village between ancient legends to arrive at the Old Mill Jesuit hosting a manufacturer of Fossa cheese. Tasting of the cheese with local wine. 
